

# Instructions for Searching SDS with ChemWatch

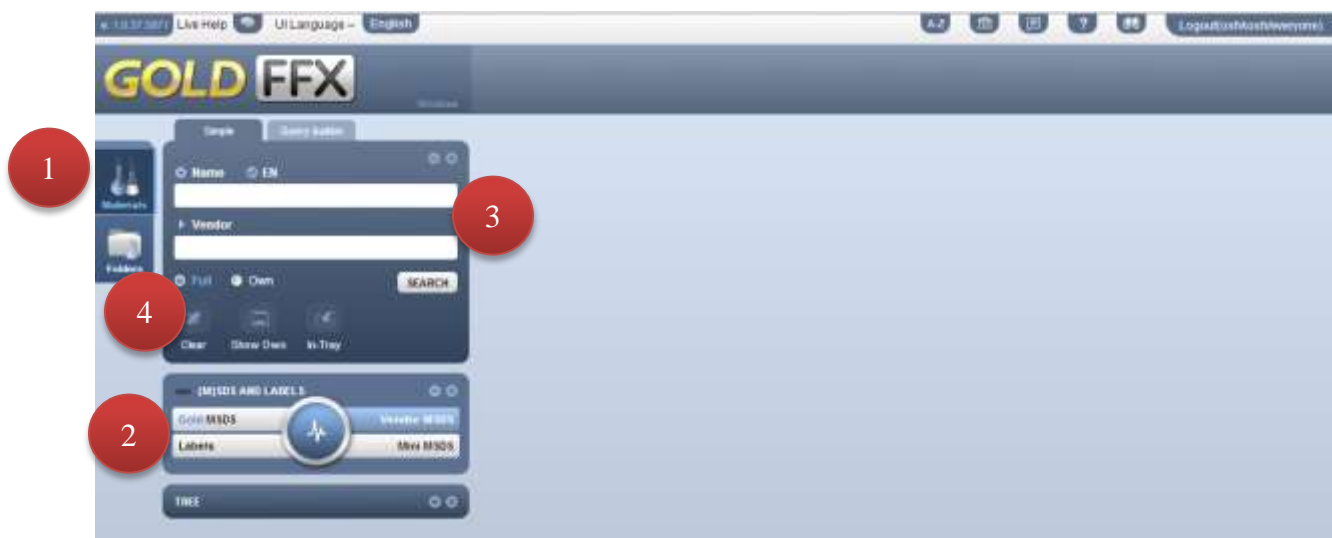
Provide the following information:

1. Click the Materials button (shown above by the red circled number 1).
2. Select the type of SDS provided. There are three options. **Mini** is the simplest to follow. In the event of an emergency be prepared to provide a **Gold** or **Vendor** SDS.  
**Vendor MSDS** is a copy of a vendor specific SDS. This is the best option for consumer or MRO products such as cleaners, degreasers, or lubricants or pesticides.  
**Gold MSDS** is a SDS specifically authored by ChemWatch. These contain additional information and recommendations for handling a material that a vendor SDS may not provide. These are ideal for chemically pure substances.  
**Mini MSDS** is a one page summary of a material containing the most important information regarding hazards, precautions, properties, and emergency/first aid information.
3. Enter the name of the material or product, for instance "Windex." You may also search by vendor, for instance SC Johnson. This is generally more useful for commercial products like cleaners and lubricants, as the search engine can be picky about names.
4. Click on the **Full** button to search the full database of 16 million + safety data sheets.
5. Click on the SEARCH button. A list of entries will be displayed. Select the one that is most appropriate. It will take a moment for the SDS to render and display. You may refine your search by specifying a vendor.
